**Solid Waste, Non Bin/Collection Services Single Family Residential Additional Automated Containers - \$6.15, \$8.48, \$3.21, and \$3.09-** The fees have been restructured to recover costs of providing the service.

**Solid Waste, Non Bin/Collection Services Senior Citizen – \$18.04, \$13.65** The fees have been restructured to recover costs.

**Solid Waste, Non Bin/Collection Services-Customers Other than Residential-\$ 15.88, \$19.81, \$29.72, \$59.44, \$17.66 and \$20.98.-** The fees have been restructured to reflect costs of providing the service and are based on container size and frequency of service.

**Solid Waste, Non Bin/Collection Services Customers Other than Residential Additional Automated Container (1x per week) \$6.15** - The fees have been restructured to recover costs of providing the service.

**Multi-Family Residential Non Bin/Collection Services \$10.48, \$15.88, \$20.98** -The fees have been restructured to reflect costs of providing the service and are based on container size

**Multi-Family Residential Non Bin/Collection Services Additional Automated Container Green Waste \$3.21** -The fees have been restructured to recover costs of providing the service.

## DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

### Additional 64-gallon, twice per week service rate

For customers other than residential, the addition of a 64-gallon container serviced once per week has been an offered service at an additional fee. The Solid Waste Management Division has experienced requests from customers to add a rate for this additional 64-gallon container serviced twice per week, to coincide with their twice a week full rate can service.

Cost recovery for this service includes current personnel costs of drivers servicing the container, tipping fees, the costs of the container, and fleet O&M costs; all included in the overall proposed fee structure for proposed rate.

Proposed Master Fee Schedule rates for an additional 64-gallon, once and twice per week:

Additional 64-gallon automated containers after first 96-gallon container:

1 day a week service / per month \$ 6.15

2 day a week service / per month \$12.30

The costs associated with providing this service twice per week are itemized below through the various components that comprise the service rate. The chart describe service provided once a week and twice a week.

**SUBJECT:** February 27, 2007 Council Action Regarding Utility Rate Increases

After careful consideration, I have decided not to veto your action to raise utility rates.

I agree with the need to play catch up and support rate increases approved by Council scheduled for April 1 and September 1, 2007. However, I have clearly communicated my position on the rate increases for September 1, 2008, 2009 and 2010. I believe strongly that Alternative A presented a rate plan that lessens the burden on family budgets, especially for the elderly and disabled on fixed incomes.

Your action to support an Amended Alternative B presents a quandary for me, because I support parts of it, but not all of it. Navigant Consulting has already provided information indicating that if a Special District was placed on the June 2008 ballot and passed, in all likelihood, rates would decrease by \$5.06 in 2008, \$5.99 in 2009 and \$6.39 in 2010. While these numbers may not be significant to some, those families, seniors and disabled that live on tight budgets will be greatly affected.

Unfortunately, over the years, politics have all too often driven the process of utility rate increases. The only viable way to extract the issue of utility rate increases from the political process and back to sound business practices where it truly belongs and best serves the people of the Fresno, is via a Special District. I encourage and expect the Council to adhere to the Utility Commission's recommendation to initiate the formation of a Special District by placing the issue on the June 2008 ballot so that the people may speak on this issue.

In addition, my final budget proposal will reflect that the September 1, 2008 rates be the lower rates associated with the formation of a Special District.



I would like to thank all of you for a job well done on evaluating this issue. Even though we may differ on some aspects, I respect your hard work and focus on the issue. This issue was certainly worthy of the time investment and focus that was committed by all of us.
