



RESOLUTION NO. 2009-229

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) AND FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDING FOR UP TO \$875,000 FOR THE HEALTHY HOMES DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, In 1999, HUD submitted to Congress a "Healthy Homes Initiative: Preliminary Plan" containing a full description of the Healthy Homes Program; and

WHEREAS, On September 21, 2009, HUD issued a grants notice which includes the Healthy Homes Demonstration Program for grants of up to \$875,000 with overall goals to mobilize public and private resources to develop the most promising, cost-effective methods for identifying and controlling key housing-related environmental; health and safety hazards; build local capacity to operate sustainable programs that will prevent and control housing-related environmental hazards in low- and very-low income residences when HUD funding is exhausted; and affirmatively further fair housing and environmental justice; and

WHEREAS, The City of Fresno desires to submit grant applications to HUD for the Healthy Homes Demonstration Program to identify and control allergens, insects, rodents, and pests in eligible privately owned housing for rental or owner-occupants and to raise public awareness and knowledge about these hazards; and

WHEREAS, The City of Fresno will enter into agreement(s) with HUD for the grant funded Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO HEREBY:

1. Approves the filing of the applications to HUD for up to \$875,000 for the Healthy Homes Demonstration Program, consistent with constitutional and local law requirements and this resolution; and
2. Certifies that the City has reviewed, understands and to the extent consistent with all constitutional and local law requirements and this resolution agrees to the provisions contained in the application and program guidelines, documents and agreements; and
3. Appoints and authorizes the City of Fresno Downtown & Community Revitalization Department Director and his/her designee(s), and each of them as agent(s) of the City of Fresno, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit documents including, but not limited to, the standard agreement, applications, amendments, memoranda of understanding and so on, which may be necessary for participation in and completion of the aforementioned Program, including any extensions or amendments thereof, subject to prior approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
